Course Length:	2 semesters, Mondays/Wednesdays 8:00am-8:55am
Course Goals:	To gain a deeper understanding of English grammar. To learn to pronounce, spell and sound out Latin sayings, prayers and songs. To encourage students to continue in their study of Latin.
Course Description:	This course is designed for the beginning Latin student and will use a traditional approach, in which instruction in systematic grammar and vocabulary precedes reading. Each lesson will consist of vocabulary words, grammar forms, and a Latin saying that teaches students about their Christian heritage. Exercises will reinforce memory work and teach grammar in incremental steps through simple translation. Prayers, songs, and Christian and classical content will be taught to add interest, understanding, and enjoyment.
