<u>STUDENTS:</u> This is your class. Talk to me (Mrs. Esposito) if you need help. I grade assignments very individually and will only ask you to do <u>your</u> best, not someone else's. Be respectful to me and your classmates, participate with a positive attitude, and turn in your work <u>on time</u>. Do those things, and you may actually enjoy an entire year of grammar! Start immediately by learning the number one rule in my class...NO FEAR. =)

EVERYONE: Being well organized is important in this class, and turning in your work completed and on time is even more important. Please let me know if you need more time on an assignment.
