- THEATER GAMES: Playing theater games develops a variety of skills.

- WARM UPS: how to warm up the voice, the body, the soul, and the mind.
- DANCE/ MOVEMENT: develop skills in a variety of styles and build physical strength to perform the moves.
- ACTING: Playing in scenes and developing characters.
- **SINGING/ VOICE WORK:** Learning skills and warm ups in acting, movement, dance, vocal to create a solid foundation for future performance and speaking opportunities.
- **PERFORMING:** creating characters in two 60 minute musical productions. (one each semester).
- **DESIGN:** Costumes, Sets, Lights, Sound, Music, Posters, Programs, Marketing, Producing, Choreography, Business Plans, Schedules. Students can be a part of many different aspects of putting on a show.
- **SERVING:** Learning to serve and help backstage or front of house to make the production come together for opening night.

- **AUDITIONS:** Students are strongly encouraged to audition (they need to audition for larger parts).
- PERFORMING: Students are strongly encouraged to perform in the play.
- BACKSTAGE: there are lots of opportunities for students to learn about the theater and be part of the team even if they don't want to be on stage.
- **SCRIPTS:** We get the scripts from licensing and will let you know when they arrive.
- **POSITIVE DISCIPLINE:** I have been trained as a Positive Discipline Coach and like to use the tools to teach students about:
  - Empathy
  - Being Kind/Firm
  - Communication: Connect before you correct
  - Boundaries
  - Respect: of themselves and the team around them
  - Mistaken Goals Chart:
    - We will review the mistaken goals chart.
    - They will use it to discover how characters and real people use these mistaken goals.
    - FOUR MISTAKEN GOALS ARE:
    - Assumed Inadequacy
    - Undue Attention
    - Misguided Power
    - Revenge
  - o Identify feelings:
    - for their characters they are playing
    - For real people in their lives
    - For themselves
